Prayer made in the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.89, dated 05.09.2016, for offence punishable under Sections 307, 353, 332, 186, 427 and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Nabha District-Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that no offence under Section 307 is made out against the petitioner and the allegation made in the FIR is false. The petitioner is not involved in the case and at the time of alleged incident, he was not present rather, the police party has falsely implicated him in the case.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI-Inderjeet Singh submits that on 03.09.2016 as per the order of SSP, Patiala, police officials were holding Naka on canal bridge Galwati for checking of the vehicles strictly coming from the Malerkotla side. At about 10.15 A.M. a white car bearing registration No.DL-1-YD-5358 driven by the accused-petitioner came from the Malerkotla side and was signaled to stop. However, on noticing the signal

given by ASI Jagdish Singh, the petitioner who was driving the car, had driven the same towards the police party on duty with high speed with intention to kill them.

Learned State counsel has also shown the videography of the said incident and the manner in which the petitioner has tried to injure the police party.

The allegations which are substantiated by the videography shown to this Court does not entitle him for anticipatory bail.

Therefore, this Court finds that the petitioner does not deserve to be admitted on anticipatory bail.

Dismissed.
