JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

Prayer is for grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. to the petitioner in case FIR No.112 dated 05.06.2014 for the offences punishable under Sections 22-61-85 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, registered with Police Station Jhabal, District Tarn Taran.

There is alleged recovery of 260 grams of *intoxicating powder* from the right pocket of pajama of the petitioner, containing *Diphenoxylate Hydrochloride*, which quantity concededly is commercial in nature.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. She further submits that the petitioner is in judicial custody since 01.07.2015.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by ASI Jagdev Singh, submits that 04 out of 06 prosecution witnesses have been examined and the remaining 02 PWs have been summoned for 02.02.2016.

Keeping in view the advance stage of the trial, no case for grant of regular bail is made out.

At this stage, learned Counsel for the petitioner/accused wishes to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
