A.B. Chaudhari, J. (Oral):

Heard learned Counsel for the rival parties. In response to the order dated 19th October, 2016, Learned Counsel for the State, upon instructions from ASI Ashwani Kumar, states that there is no other case of similar nature registered against the petitioner.

Seen the allegations against the petitioner about the petitioner having stocked 70 bottles of liquor make Yes Goa Premium Whisky along with 75 nips of above whisky. This being the first offence against the petitioner, I think relief of grant of anticipatory bail should be extended to him subject to the undertaking to be furnished by him to the effect that he will not indulge in such offence hereinafter.

Petition is allowed. In the event of arrest, petitioner shall be released on ad-interim anticipatory bail in FIR No.183 dated 12.9.2016, registered under Section 16/1/14 of the Punjab Excise Act, at Police Station

Dera Basi, District SAS Nagar, on furnishing of his bail bond amounting to ₹10,000/- with one surety of like amount to the satisfaction of the arresting officer. He shall, however, join the investigation and fully cooperate with the Investigating Officer.
