This is a petition for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.92, dated 15.06.2016 registered under Sections 420/465/468/471/120-B IPC at Police Station City-1, Malerkotla, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that there has been a long outstanding civil dispute between the parties about this very plot of land.

Learned counsel for the complainant states that actually this is a case where the petitioner has usurped the property belonging to the complainant and is using various stratagems to deny them the fruits of their purchase.

Learned Deputy Advocate General and learned counsel for the complainant, however, accepted that there is a long outstanding dispute about this property.

Resultantly, the petition is allowed. In the event of arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
