Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C., seeking regular bail in case FIR No.52 dated 06.05.2015, registered at Police Station Raja Sansi, District Amritsar, under Sections 420, 120-B IPC and Section 66 of the I.T. Act, 2000.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that the co-accused was granted bail by this Court vide order dated 21.09.2016, passed in Criminal Misc.No.M-32537 of 2016 and the petitioner has been in custody since 06.05.2015.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, has accepted these factual assertions.

Keeping in view the facts that the co-accused was granted the benefit of regular bail and the petitioner is in custody since 06.05.2015, I

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deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
