Petitioner seeks concession of pre-arrest bail in a case registered at the instance of Devinder Singh, complainant alleging that the petitioner as a member of unlawful assembly had assaulted the complainant and others. The petitioner is attributed a kirpan blow on the hands of the complainant resulting in fracture of the right fore arm and right first and second metacarpel bone.

Learned counsel for the complainant has intervened to show that the injured had to undergo plastic surgery and operation for the repair of the fracture. Petitioner appears to be a main accused who had caused grievous injury with sharp edged weapon on the hand and arm of the complainant. There appears to be a motive on account of previous quarrel between the parties. No extraordinary exceptional circumstances exist to grant the concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the

petitioner himself is suffering from the spinal injury, as such he should be granted the concession of pre-arrest bail.

I have considered the said circumstance and I am of the opinion that the said ground may constitute a good ground for grant of regular bail but no extraordinary exceptional circumstances exist to grant the concession of pre-arrest bail.

The petition is dismissed.
