The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 977 dated 07.07.2015 registered at Police Station City, Panipat under Sections 363/366A IPC.

The prosecutrix was missing from the house since 04.07.2015. A missing report was lodged by the father. The girl was recovered on 30.03.2015. She had made a statement under Section 164 Cr.P.C. and did not make any allegation against the petitioner. She also refused her medical. The challan was presented under Sections 363, 366 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner had submitted on the last date of hearing that the girl has again run away from the home and another DDR has been registered. Copy of the DDR has been placed on record, according to which the second incident took place in February 2016. The victim has again refused her medical after her recovery on 02.03.2016.

Learned State counsel submits that four main witnesses have been examined.

The petitioner is in custody since 31.07.2015.

Considering the entirety and without commenting anything on the merits of the case and the fact that the trial will take time to conclude, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing adequate bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
