The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (Cr.P.C.) for grant of concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case First Information Report No.203 dated 05.09.2016 under Section 306, 34 of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Nathana, District Bathinda.

Mr. A.K. Khunger, Advocate has filed his power of attorney on behalf of the complainant which is taken on record.

On instructions from Head Constable Pardeep Kumar, learned State counsel submits that in compliance of order dated 26.10.2016 the petitioner had joined investigation and nothing remains to be recovered from her.
