This petition has been filed for quashing the order dated 15.07.2016 passed by the trial Court declining an application to send some documents which were submitted by the respondent-complainant for examination by CFSL or any other laboratory.

The trial Court has come to the conclusion that these documents are not relevant. In my opinion, even if this conclusion is not called for yet the fact remains that whatever the petitioner may want to show from those documents can be shown by him during his defence evidence and his prayer for sending to CFSL is not maintainable in view of these observations.

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This petition stands dismissed.
