Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to the official respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 8.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is being threatened to compromise the matter and to resile from the statement made in the FIR registered at the behest of the petitioner.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

On asking of this Court, Mr. Gurinderjit Singh, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case and taking into consideration the apprehension to the life and liberty of the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Barnala to look into the contents of representation dated 20.9.2016 (Annexure P-1) and to take appropriate action in accordance with law.
