Reply of Sh. Baljinder Singh, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Assandh, Karnal on behalf of respondent No.1-State of Haryana has been filed in Court today and same is taken on record.

Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of cross version of FIR No.163, dated 28.04.2005, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 325 and 326 IPC, Police Station Assandh, District Karnal along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

Instant case stands registered at the instance of Om Prakash son of Mansa Ram on the allegations that Gopi and others inflicted injuries to Maha Singh (uncle of respondent No.3) and Fata.

In compliance of order dated October 20, 2015, report of Ld. Additional Sessions Judge has been received, in which, it has been categorically observed that compromise is genuine one because both the parties assembled in the Court and made statements voluntarily. Even otherwise, the matter involved is personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

In view of the above I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

Consequently, present petition stands allowed and cross version of FIR No.163, dated 28.04.2005, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 325 and 326 IPC, Police Station Assandh, District Karnal and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua the petitioners.
