Counsel for the petitioner says that in compliance of the order dated 11.03.2016, passed by this Court, a sum of Rs.20,000/- has been paid to the complainant. He further says that after submission of cancellation report when the matter was before the Mediation Centre, the complainant had filed a complaint under the Domestic Violence Act on 29.09.2016.

Looking to all these circumstances, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 21.10.2015 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
