For having been found in possession of 1020 tablets of alprazolam, the petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. 14.08.2015. He remained on interim bail for some period.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has not misused his liberty, as such he may be granted concession of bail.

As the quantity of alprazolam recovered is commercial quantity, this petition is disposed of with a direction that in case the trial is not concluded within a period of six months after the next date of hearing, the trial Court will be at liberty to release the petitioner on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to its satisfaction.
