This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to take action against respondents No.4 to 6 on the basis of complaints dated 22.07.2016 (Annexures P-6 and P-7) submitted to the police authorities by the petitioner and further to register a case against them under the relevant provisions of Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

On the asking of Court, Mr. RPS Sidhu, AAG, Punjab, has accepted notice on behalf of respondents-State of Punjab. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

The contention of learned counsel for the petitioner is that though representations Annexures P-6 and P-7 were moved on 22nd July, 2016 and even subsequent reminder was also given on 19th August, 2016, till date no action has been taken by respondents No.2 and 3.

The instant petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka, District Fazilka to look into the grievances unfolded by petitioner in his representation dated 22nd July,

2016 (Annexures P-6 and P-7) and if some substance is found, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
