Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C.
is for quashing of FIR No.249 dated 23.11.2011 under Sections
419, 420, 465, 467, 471, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station,
Adampur, Jalandhar City, *qua* the petitioner.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Sewa
Dass, states that in the case in hand, the police has already
submitted the challan and charges have been framed by the trial
Court.

In view of the aforesaid, this Court does not deem it appropriate to interfere in the matter.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition, however, he submits that taking into consideration the nature of offences alleged in the FIR, the petitioner be granted exemption from personal appearance.

This petition is dismissed as not pressed, with liberty to the petitioner to approach the trial Court with regard to his prayer for granting him exemption from personal appearance, who shall consider the prayer of the petitioner in accordance with law.
