Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.575 dated 7.8.2016, under Section 15/16/61/85 of the NDPS Act (Section 16 of the NDPS Act mentioned in the impugned order but not in the FIR), registered at Police Station City Sirsa, District Sirsa.

Learned State counsel states that taking advantage of the situation, the petitioner, who owned the motor-cycle, ran away from the spot.

There is specific allegation that the contraband was recovered from the petitioner along with his co-accused Sunil. The said co-accused Sunil has further disclosed the identity of the petitioner, who ran away from the spot and the fact that the motorcycle involved in the case belongs to the petitioner. In this manner, there are serious allegations against the petitioner.

Therefore, no case for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made out.

Dismissed.
