The present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, "Cr.P.C.") for grant of concession of regular bail to the petitioner in case bearing First Information Report No.244 dated 17.09.2015 under Sections 21/61/85 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Sadar, Ferozepur.

The submissions made by learned counsel representing the petitioner and learned counsel representing the State of Punjab have been heard.

It is submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the only allegation against him was that 260 grams of heroin was recovered from him. The recovery of the contraband i.e. heroin was marginally higher than the limit fixed for commercial quantity. Earlier the petitioner was granted the concession of interim bail and there is no allegation that she had misused the concession of bail. She is a young lady and pending trial she be enlarged on regular bail.

Indeed, the trial of the case will take some time. Recovery of the contraband has already been effected and there appears no plausible ground to detain the petitioner further in custody. Accordingly, she is admitted to bail, subject to her furnishing bail/ surety bonds, to the satisfaction of Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Ferozepur.

Petition is accordingly allowed.
