The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 122 dated 11.08.2015 registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Batala, District Gurdaspur under Sections 341, 354, 354-A, 354-B, 354-D, 295-A, 506, 379, 323, 34 IPC and Section 7 and 8 of Prevention of Children from sexual Offences Act and subsequently Section 376 IPC has been added.

The vagina swab has been taken which has been sent to the FSL. The report has not been received.

Heard.

The name of the petitioner finds mention in the complaint given by the father. He had also been named by the prosecutrix. A supplementary statement was given by the victim wherein she has accused the petitioner of taking her to a hotel for a party where some tablets have been administered and when she was under its influence she was raped.

The girl is stated to be 16–16 ½ years. Learned counsel for the complainant has stated that there is pressure for compromise and threats are being given.

Considering the allegations and the conduct no case for anticipatory bail is made out.

The petition is dismissed.
