**INDERJIT SINGH, J.**

Petitioner, Krishan Kumar has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.125 dated 11.06.2016, registered at Police Station Kotwali Patiala, District Patiala, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B, 409 and 380 IPC.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the present petitioner is stated to be posted as clerk and allegations against him are that he has committed the theft of vouchers etc. and handed over the same to accused-Sunil Kumar.

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The present petitioner has not been named in the FIR. He has been nominated on the basis of disclosure statement of main accused, Sunil Kumar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner argued that there is no evidence on record to prove the allegations against the present petitioner except the disclosure statement of co-accused.

The present petitioner is in custody since 22.06.2016. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
