Prayer in this petition is for directing respondents no.2 and 3 to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents no.4 and 5.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sulakhan Singh, submits that the petitioners are not traceable on the address given in the petition and therefore, they could not be contacted.

Learned counsel for respondent no.4 and 5 states that they have no objection to the marriage of the petitioners and there is no threat perception whatsoever to the petitioners from them.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition and the same is accordingly disposed of.

However, in case the petitioners still feel that there is any threat to their life and liberty, they may approach Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, Mohali, respondent no.2, who shall redress their grievance, if any, in accordance with law.
