JASPAL SINGH, J.(ORAL)

By virtue of the instant petition preferred under Section 439 of Code of Criminal Procedure, petitioners have sought bail, during the pendency of the trial, in case bearing FIR No.841 dated 22.09.2016, under Sections 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 of Immoral Traffic (Prevention) Act, 1956, registered at Police Station Sadar, Karnal.

Petitioners were allegedly found in a compromising position with a girl at Haryana Tourism Karan Lake Resort and were arrested in this case. Since the date of their arrest i.e. 22nd September, 2016, they are cooling their heels behind the bars. It is a matter of evidence that petitioners were indulging in illegal or immoral activities. After the interrogation of the petitioners, they were sent to judicial custody, meaning thereby, they were not required for further interrogation. Moreover, presentation of challan and disposal thereof, is likely to take sufficient long time. In the given facts and circumstances, this Court is of the considered view that no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioners behind the bars for an indefinite period.

Taking into consideration the aforesaid aspects of the case but without expressing any opinion on merits, petition is allowed and petitioners are ordered to be released on bail on their furnishing requisite bonds at the satisfaction of the concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate
