Kuldip Singh, J. (Oral):

The petition is for quashing of FIR No.54 dated 9.2.2010, registered under Section 381 IPC, at Police Station Division No.5, Ludhiana, along with all consequential proceedings.

Report of Judicial Magistrate First Class, Ludhiana received. Learned Magistrate has recorded the statements of the complainant as well as the accused. The complainant as well as the accused have stated that they have effected compromise which is genuine ad without any pressure and coercion.

Since the parties have compromised, therefore, FIR No.54 dated 9.2.2010, registered under Section 381 IPC, at Police Station Division No.5, Ludhiana, along with consequential proceedings stands quashed.

The petition is accordingly allowed.
