The prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.183 dated 03.11.2015 for the offence under Sections 420, 494, 498-A and 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar at Ludhiana.

Petitioner is in custody since 28.09.2016. The FIR has been registered by complainant with the allegation for committing fraud, harassment, demand of dowry and threats to her life.

Learned counsel for the State submits on instructions from HC Om Parkash, that challan has been presented on 25.11.2016 and no dowry articles are required to be recovered from the petitioner.

Keeping in view the above and the fact that trial is likely to take time to its conclusion, petitioner be released on regular bail on furnishing his fresh bail bonds/sureties to the satisfaction of Duty Magistrate/Illaq Magistrate, Ludhiana.
