The petitioners seek pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.37 dated 09.04.2014, registered under Sections 323 and 326 read with Section 34 of the IPC, at P.S. Dasuya, Distt. Hoshiarpur.

Heard.

On 21.10.2015, the following order was passed:-

“Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.37 dated 09.04.2014 for offences punishable under Sections 323, 326 and 34 of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur.

As per the allegations, both the petitioners are alleged to have caught hold of the complainant Niranjn Singh while the main accused gave fist blows on the left eye of the complainant causing a grievous injury. There are allegations of removal of gold chain and snatching of Rs.9500/-.

It is contended that the main co-accused Manjit Singh @ Vicky was granted anticipatory bail by this Court.

Notice of motion for 14.12.2015.

In the meanwhile, in the event of their arrest, petitioners shall be released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the arresting/investigating officer. However, they shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.PC.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 21.10.2015, is made absolute, subject to furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petition stands allowed.
