JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

By virtue of instant petition preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C., petitioner has sought the directions to official respondents No.3 to 5 for arresting the accused-respondents No. 6 to 8 in case FIR No. 27 dated 19.04.2012 under Section 302 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar, Kapurthala with further prayer to hand over the investigation to respondent No.2 or to some independent agency.

2. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Balbir Singh, Police Station Sadar, Kapurthala, has submitted that after the completion of investigation in this case untraced report has already been furnished in the Court

of learned Jurisdictional Magistrate.

3. In view of submission of untraced report, instant petition has rendered infructuous and is dismissed, as such.

4. However, petitioner shall be at liberty to have recourse to other remedies available to him under law.
