Through the instant petition, the petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.295 dated 27.11.2015, registered under Sections 376/452/324/323 of IPC, Police Station Sadar Ferozepur, Distt. Ferozepur.

Learned States counsel submits that Section 376 IPC was deleted. He further submits that recovery of weapons have been effected.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the interim order dated 25.10.2016, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and has cooperated.

Learned State counsel states that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Looking to all these circumstances, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 25.10.2016 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
