Report dated 05.11.2015 sent by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Batala has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Rajesh Kumar @ Phul @ Sonu, Manjit Singh @ Sonu, Mannu Devgan as well as of complainant Bikramjit Singh it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that it is non-injury case and that the parties have effected a compromise for the offences which are not of heinous nature which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.94 dated 01.12.2014 under Section 336,506,148,149 IPC and Sections 25 (54) of Arms Act Police Station,

Fatehgarh Churian, District Gurdaspur and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioners.

Petition stands disposed off.
