Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.172 dated 08.09.2016, registered at Police Station Bhargo Camp, District Jalandhar.

On 20.10.2016, this Court passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner states that similarly situated co-accused was granted interim protection by way of order dated 07.10.2016.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. B.S.Thind, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. Learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes to supply a copy of the petition to the learned State counsel during the course of the day.

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To come up along with CRM-M-36276 of 2016 on 01.12.2016.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest of the petitioner he shall be released on interim bail by the investigating officer subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. The petitioner shall also join the investigation and appear before the investigating officer as and when his presence is required.”

Learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for complainant have no objection if the instant petition is allowed.

Ordered accordingly.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 20.10.2016, passed by this Court, is made absolute.
