JASPAL SINGH, J.(ORAL)

Through the instant petition preferred under Section 439 of Code of Criminal Procedure, petitioner has sought concession of bail, pending trial, in case bearing FIR No.206 dated 17.11.2015, under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B, registered at Police Station Bawal, District Rewari Haryana.

Undoubtedly, the petitioner was arrested in this case on 22nd June, 2016 and after subjecting her to custodial interrogation, she was remanded to judicial custody, meaning thereby, she was not required by the Police for further interrogation. The only allegation against the present petitioner is that she arranged two girls by paying price for their appearance before the Sub Registrar at the time of fabrication of the sale deed in place of the original owners. Though, the petitioner is suffering incarceration since the date of her arrest i.e. last about six months, the Investigating Agency is unable to trace out the whereabouts of those girls. During the course of arguments, it has also emerged that on conclusion of the investigation, report under Section 173(2) Cr.P.C. has already been

presented, the disposal of which is likely to take sufficient long time. Even otherwise, complainant, namely, Preeti and Sarita have already preferred civil suit challenging the sale deed in question which is alleged to be forged and fabricated.

Taking into consideration the aforesaid aspects of the case but without expressing any opinion on merits, petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on her furnishing requisite bonds at the satisfaction of the concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.
