The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.199, dated 15.12.2013, registered under Section 21 of the NDPS Act, at Police Station Bhogpur, District Jalandhar.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the recovery in this case is 200 grams of heroin which is non-commercial quantity. The petitioner was released on bail but could not appear on one date because

he was arrested in another case. The petitioner is ready to face the trial

and would never misuse the concession of bail.

Counsel for the respondent, on instructions from HC Narinder Kumar, has accepted the factual assertions.

In these circumstances, the petitioner is directed to appear before the trial Court on 7.11.2016 and the trial Court shall release him on bail to its satisfaction. This petition stands disposed of.
