The petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. 29.06.2015, on the basis of the recovery of five Indian passports, one driving license and three forged visa stickers of Canada having been effected.

Learned State counsel informed that the stickers have been sent to the Embassy for determining the authenticity.

Without expression of any opinion on merits, it is sufficient to observe that the petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. 29.06.2015. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody during entire period of the trial.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed. The petitioner

is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
