JAISHREE THAKUR, J. (Oral)

This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuing directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to conduct the investigation expeditiously, fairly and properly.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that marriage of daughter of the petitioner was solemnized with respondent No.4 on 18.11.2015, however, she died on 20.05.2016. It is contended that the police has not investigated the case fairly on account of the fact that daughter of the petitioner was poisoned on 10.03.2016.

Notices were issued in the petition and a reply has been filed by

respondents No.1 to 3-State, in which, it is submitted that the matter was investigated and after detailed investigation, it has been found that the deceased was suffering from incurable disease called Systemic Lupus Ery Metosis for the past nine years and she was taking treatment for this disease. It is also submitted that a detailed enquiry was held in this regard, after associating both the parties and while also recording the statement of Dr. Pankaj Aggarwal of IVY Hospital, Amritsar, who stated in his report that Praybhjot Kaur was suffering from diseases since the last nine years.

In view of the fact that an enquiry has been conducted and the same exonerates the private respondents herein, no further action are called for in this regard.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be given liberty to challenge the enquiry report.

Needless to say that this remedy is always available to him and the petitioner herein can avail all appropriate legal remedies, in accordance with law.

The petition stands disposed of.
