This petition is for issuance of appropriate directions to the official respondents not to harass the petitioners at the instance of private respondent Nos.5 to 9.

Learned State counsel has filed the reply by way of affidavit of Varinderjeet Singh, DSP, Payal, on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. Same is taken on record. Copy supplied to the counsel opposite.

As per reply, the age of petitioner No.1 has been verified from the school record. The certificate issued by the Principal, Government Senior Secondary School, Village Nasrali, District Ludhiana annexed with

the reply shows that the age of petitioner No.1-Sandeep Kaur is 15.02.1996. Alongwith the reply, affidavits of the petitioners namely Amandeep Singh and Sandeep Kaur have been filed and as per which, the petitioners have no apprehension from anyone and as such does not require any protection.

In view of the facts narrated above and taking into consideration the reply submitted by respondents No.1 to 3, no further action is required in the case. Accordingly, the petition is disposed of.

However, in case petitioners feel that they apprehend and need any security, they are at liberty to approach to the Senior Superintendent of Police concerned.
