The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 59 dated 16.02.2015 registered at Police Station Tosham under Sections 376, 306, 120-B IPC and Section 4 of the POCSO Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was arrested on 17.02.2015 but the complainant, the grand father and the uncle who were the only private witnesses did not support the prosecution case at the trial and only the official witnesses remain to be examined. The counsel refers to Annexure P-3.

The petitioner is in custody since February 2015 and the private witnesses have been examined who have not supported the prosecution case.

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case and considering the fact that the trial will take time to conclude, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing adequate bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
