The Insurance Company is in appeal against the award on an issue of liability. The point pleaded was that the driver had a licence to driver a light motor vehicle and he was driving a tractor. Tractor is a light motor vehicle and the possession of LMV licence is good enough to consider the driver to be duly licensed. The challenge cannot survive favourable consideration. The appeal is dismissed.
