This petition has been filed for grant of regular bail to the petitioner pending trial in case bearing FIR No.40 dated 25.06.2016, under Sections 354-B, 384, 341, 328, 201, 120-B, 506 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 12 of the POSCO Act and Section 66-E of the I.T. Act, registered at Police Station Women Sonapat, District Sonapat.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that petitioner was arrested on 16.07.2016 under the said FIR and in fact, was arrested on a statement made by main accused namely Bhupesh Sapra that the accused-petitioner was demanding money and blackmailing her regarding some obscene photographs, taken of the prosecutrix. It is also

contended that the statement of prosecutrix has been recorded on 24.10.2016, in which, she has stated that she does not recognize the petitioner.

In view of the fact that statement of prosecutrix has been recorded and that petitioner has been in custody since 16.07.2016 and is not required for any investigation, the instant petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
