By virtue of instant petition preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C. petitioners have sought direction to respondent Nos.2 & 3 to protect their lives and liberty at the hands of private respondent Nos.4 to 13 and not to harass in any manner.

In response to notice of motion issued by this Court, reply by way of affidavit of Rattandeep, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Punhana has been filed on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3.

A glance at the aforesaid reply makes it clear that on receipt of notice of this petition, an inquiry has been conducted by the local police and during that inquiry, petitioners as well as private respondents were associated and the petitioners have made statements which are Annexures

CRM NO. M-3743 of 2016

R-3 & R-4 clearly unfolded that they have no apprehension or danger to their lives and liberty at the hands of private respondents. Similar fact, the statements of the private respondents have also been recorded, in which they have stated that they will not create any problem or danger to the lives and liberty of the petitioners.

In view of the above facts and circumstances, instant petition has rendered infructuous. As such, the same stands disposed of.
