JASWANT SINGH, J (ORAL)

Prayer is under Section 439 Cr.PC for grant of regular bail to the petitioner, namely, Nishan Singh in case FIR No.145 dated 08.10.2014 for offences punishable under Sections 323, 324, 325, 307 and 34 of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Goindwal Sahib, Punjab.

As per the case of the prosecution, the accused-petitioner along with his two co-accused and another accused Ajmer Singh entered the house of the complainant at 12.00 Noon and thereafter are alleged to have caused injuries on the person of the complainant and his father Jasbir Singh.

The present accused is attributed two *Dattar* blows, one on the head and other on the shoulder of the injured father-Jasbir Singh.

It is contended that there is a version and cross version. Petitioner is stated to be in custody since 27.04.2015 and after framing of the charge on 25.05.2015, the evidence of the prosecution is still at the initial stage as only one PW out of the 17 cited Pws has since been examined.

Learned State Counsel assisted by ASI Gurmukh Singh does not dispute the aforesaid factual position.

Learned Counsel for the complainant has opposed the application for grant of bail.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, keeping in view the custody period and the fact that the trial is not likely to be concluded in near future, present petition is allowed and the petitioner Nishan Singh is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of learned CJM/Duty Magistrate, Tarn Taran.

Petition stands disposed of.
