The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 920 dated 29.12.2015, registered under Sections 304-B/34 IPC, Police Station Ballabhgarh, District Faridabad.

Heard.

The deceased was married to the son of the petitioners in December, 2013. The incident took place on 19.12.2015. The accusations levelled were that the petitioners and their family members had poured kerosine oil and had set the daughter-in-law on fire. The family levelled allegations of dowry harassment

against the petitioners and the husband. The deceased had eight months old child. Though it is claimed that there are separate ration cards but the petitioners live in the same house. Considering the allegations no case for anticipatory bail is made out.

The petition is dismissed.
