Kuldip Singh, J. (Oral):

The petition is for quashing of FIR No.161 dated 23.12.2013, registered under Sections 323, 341, 506, 34 IPC, at Police Station Anandpur Sahib, District Ropar, along with all consequential proceedings.

Report of Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Anandpur Sahib received. Learned Magistrate has recorded the statements of the complainant as well as the accused. The complainant as well as the accused have stated that they have reached compromise and in this regard written compromise dated 3.10.2015 (Mark-A) has been recorded voluntarily and without any undue influence, pressure or coercion from any side.

Since the parties have compromised, therefore, FIR No.161 dated 23.12.2013, registered under Sections 323, 341, 506, 34 IPC, at Police Station Anandpur Sahib, District Ropar, along with consequential proceedings stands quashed.

The petition is accordingly allowed.
