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KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

The present petition has been filed by Gurbhej Singh for conducting an inquiry into the illegal confinement of the petitioner for 25 days by official respondents No. 4 to 8. The prayer has also been made for registering an FIR against official respondents No. 4 to 8.

Reply filed. It is stated that earlier Darshan Singh, grandfather of the petitioner had filed a habeas corpus petition i.e. CRWP No. 1405 of 1015 for release of the detainee, in which the Warrant Officer was appointed and he made the report on 23.9.2015 that there is no illegal detention. Thereafter, on 30.9.2015, the mother of the petitioner filed a similar petition i.e. CRWP No. 1407 of 2015 before this Court regarding same incident. Again, the father of

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the petitioner also filed the similar petition regarding the same incident. Now, this is fourth petition filed by the petitioner. It is stated in the reply that two FIRs against the present petitioner and three FIRs against Sukhpal Singh, father of the petitioner, have already been registered.

It being so, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner that if he feels that some crime was committed against him, he should approach the learned Illaqa Magistrate under the relevant provisions of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.
