The grievance of the petitioner is that his liberty is being curtailed by the police officials by visiting his house at odd hours.

Through instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks a direction to the respondents for complying with the provisions of Section 160 Cr.P.C.

The petitioner has not filed any representation to any senior police officer regarding the harassment being caused.

This petition is disposed of as premature with liberty to the petitioner to first approach the senior police authorities expressing his grievance. In case the liberty of the petitioner is still curtailed, the

petitioner have got remedy to approach this Court again. It is expected that in case any representation is filed in appropriate manner, the same would be considered expeditiously.
