Petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. 02.06.2015 in a case registered at the instance of Dilpreet Kaur alleging that the petitioner along with other co-accused had snatched her purse containing a gold ring, voter card etc. while she was traveling in a rickshaw.

On the last date of hearing i.e. 23.12.2015, learned counsel for the petitioner had stated that the complainant has been examined in the Court and that she has not identified the petitioner and his co-accused.

Statement of complainant Dilpreet Kaur has been placed on record by learned State counsel wherein she has identified the accused and the case property.

In view of said circumstances, no ground is made out to grant concession of bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.
