Petitioner, Bhuvnesh Sood has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.173 dated 13.11.2009, registered at Police Station Morinda, under Sections 467, 468, 471, 420 and 522 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued in this case. Learned State counsel put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the petitioner absented from the court proceedings on 17.08.2016; his bail was cancelled and non-bailable warrants were issued against him.

In view of the interim order dated 21.10.2016 passed by this

Court, the petitioner appeared before the trial Court and has been released on interim bail.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details; without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and the facts that trial of the case will take a long time and no useful purpose would be served by sending the petitioner to custody, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 21.10.2016, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute.
