Instant petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of directions to official respondents No. 1 to 4 to conduct free and fair investigation in case FIR No. 77, dated 19.09.2016, under Sections 307, 148, 149 IPC and Section 25/27 of the Arms Act, Police Station SGN Dev Thermal Plant, District Bathinda OR to decide the representation dated 06.10.2016 (Annexure P-2)

2. Notice of motion to respondent Nos.1 to 4 -State only, at this stage.
3. On the asking of Court, Mr. J.S. Sekhon, AAG, Punjab has accepted notice on behalf of respondent-State. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of the day.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though representation dated 06.10.2016 (Annexure P-2) was moved to Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda but till date no action has been taken.

5. The instant petition is disposed of with direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda at Police Headquarter Bathinda-respondent No.2, to inquire into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated 06.10.2016 (Annexure P-2) and if some substance is found, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
