Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondent Nos. 6 to 10.

Mr. K.S. Dadwal, Advocate appears for the respondent No.6 – father of the petitioner No.1 and states that he and his wife may be allowed to meet her daughter-petitioner No.1.

Request has been accepted. They have met the petitioner

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No.1 in the Chamber of this Court. Even thereafter, the daughter-petitioner No.1 is adamant that she wants to live with the boy-petitioner No.2.

The petitioners have got married against the wishes of their parents. In support of her proof of age petitioner No.1 has placed on record a copy of the Aadhar Card (Annexure P-1) wherein her date of birth is mentioned as 26.02.1991 whereas petitioner No.2 has also placed on record a copy of Adhaar Card (Annexure P-2) depicting his year of birth as 1986. They have also moved a representation before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiapur (Annexure P-5) for protection of their life and liberty.

Without adverting to the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiapur to take appropriate action on the said representation (Annexure P-5).

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
