Learned State counsel has placed on record reply by way of affidavit of Ashish Chaudhary, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Headquarters, Nuh on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 and on instructions from ASI Ajay Kumar, Police Station Nuh, District Mewat, submits that the petitioners have made statements before the police that threat to their life and personal liberty no more exists.

Since there is no representation on behalf of the petitioners and nothing survives in the present petition, the same stands dismissed having been rendered infructuous.
