This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in a case registered against the petitioner under Section 15,16,61,85 of Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 and later on added offence under section 27-A of the Act, vide FIR No.49 dated 07.03.2014.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that petitioner has been falsely implicated in the case. He submits that petitioner has neither been named in the FIR nor was arrested at the spot and he has been involved on the basis of disclosure statement of the co-accused. Thus, petitioner deserves concession of bail.

Prayer has been opposed by the State counsel on the ground that petitioner was the main supplier and a heavy quantity of contraband was supplied by him to co-accused Jagtar Singh and Sukhdev Singh for selling the same in Punjab. Thereafter, Section 27-A of the Act was
