This petition under Section 438 of the Criminal Procedure Code has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.348 dated 06.10.2014 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code (in short 'IPC') at Police Station City Kotwali, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. The cheque in dispute was not only signed by the complainant himself but even the over writing upon the cheque was also counter signed by him. Learned counsel further submits that present bail petition is filed by petitioner who was petitioner No.3 in earlier petitions only because of the fact that he being student and under treatment for tuberculosis at relevant time and resigned from the company on 17.07.2014 whereas the FIR was registered on 06.10.2014.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the case file.

This is a third bail application. First two applications were dismissed on merits on 21.11.2014 and 31.08.2016 respectively.

No fresh circumstances in favour of petitioner is made out.

Consequently, bail application stands dismissed.
