The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.133, dated 10.9.2015, registered under Sections 392/397 of the IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Satnali, District Mahendergarh.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that co-accused of the petitioner was granted bail by the trial Court after he had undergone period of two months and nine days on the ground that the case is triable

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by Magistrate. The present petitioner has undergone a period of 3 months and 26 days as is borne out from the custody certificate filed by way of affidavit of Sanjay Singh, Superintendent, District Prison, Narnaul.

In these circumstances, I see no ground to take a different view. Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands disposed of.
